

**CONSERVATION BOARD MEMBER OPENING**  
**(Fill Vacancy for an unexpired term ending December 31, 2023)**

**The Chickasaw County Conservation Board has a Board Member opening for Supervisor District #4.**

The district is bounded by the corner of 170<sup>th</sup> Street and LaSalle Avenue in Jacksonville Township, the East on the centerline of 170<sup>th</sup> Street, then North along the centerline of McCloud Avenue, then East along the centerline of 170<sup>th</sup> Street, thence East on the centerline of 160<sup>th</sup> Street, then South along the East side of Jacksonville Township and the East side of New Hampton Township to the centerline of 250<sup>th</sup> Street, then West of 250<sup>th</sup> Street to the centerline of McCloud Avenue and continuing North on the centerline of South Line Avenue, North Line Avenue and LaSalle Avenue to the centerline of 170<sup>th</sup> Street to the point of beginning including Precincts 1 and 4 of the City of New Hampton., The parts of Precinct 2 and 3 of the City of New Hampton lying East of North Linn Avenue and South Linn Avenue are not included in the district. Person interested in this position should understand the Conservation Board has the responsibility to conserve local natural resources, create and enhance these resources, and promote the health and welfare of the local people through an organized program of public recreation. The successful applicant must have the time and energy to devote to Conservation Board activities. Meetings are held once a month, and regular attendance is required. The applicant should plan to devote more than one or two hours each month to being a Conservation Board member. Persons interested in this position will need to work cooperatively in a group setting, be able to set conservation priorities, be able to receive and investigate conservation related complaints, and be able to develop a budget and exercise budget oversight.
