The Chickasaw County Sheriffs Office is currently accepting applications for the position of a full-time patrol Deputy. ILEA Certification preferred, but not required. Lateral transfers will be accepted.

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- U.S. Citizen
- 18 years of age
- Valid Driver's License
- Be of good moral character
- Physical fitness test standards set by the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy for non-certified applicants
- Undergo cognitive (basic skills) testing for non-certified applicants
- High School diploma or GED
- Psychological test
- Pass an extensive background check
- Live in Chickasaw County

Chickasaw County Deputies work 6 days on with 3 consecutive days off at 8.5-hour shifts. Deputies are provided with all the necessary equipment including an outer carrier ballistic vest as well as a take home vehicle. Chickasaw County offers IPERS, Medical (free for employee) and Dental Insurance. Chickasaw County Deputies recognize 10.5 paid holidays a year, paid vacation (starting at 2 weeks for certified applicants on hire date), paid sick leave and family medical leave. Starting wage is \$25.54/hr and \$26.88/hr upon completion of probation.
